Due to the COVID-19 pandemic Addison Township has put a plan in place to continue to care about the well being of all our residents, clients, staff and volunteers.

We are asking everyone to remain in your vehicles for food, which is pre-bagged. Each vehicle will be given the same amount of food. Staff will directly place pre-bagged food in your vehicle.

This will also assist with the "social distancing" that has been recommended by the CDC.
