**A RESOLUTION OF THE ADDISON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION

TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT, TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF
THE TOWNSHIP AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
NOVEMBER 5, 2024**

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Township of Addison, DuPage County, Illinois, (the “Township”) is a township duly organized and existing under Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Township is located in DuPage County, which has a population of less than 3,000,000 inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the Addison Township Road District (a/k/a Addison Township Highway Department) (the “Road District”) is a single township road district located entirely within Addison Township;

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Trustees, by Resolution, is authorized by law to submit a proposition to the electors of the Township at a general or consolidated election asking whether the Road District should be abolished as a matter of law pursuant to Section 6-134 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/6-134);

WHEREAS, if the majority of electors of the Township vote to abolish the Road District pursuant to Section 6-134 of the Highway Code, the Township will assume all rights, duties, assets, property, liability, obligations and responsibilities of the Road District upon its abolishment;

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined by the Township Board of Trustees that abolition of the Road District shall not be detrimental to the continued operation of the Township or to the residents of the Township;

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Trustees hereby deems it advisable, necessary, and in the best interests of the Township that the Proposition whether to abolish the Road District be submitted to the voters of the Township at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election laws and that the voters of the Township be permitted to decide whether to abolish the Road District by operation of law.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Addison Township, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The foregoing Recitals are true and correct, and said Recitals are incorporated herein as if written out here in full.

Section 2: The Addison Township Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the following binding proposition (the “Binding Proposition”) to be placed on the ballot and submitted to the voters of the Township at the General Election to be held on November 5, 2024 (the “Election”), in substantially the following form pursuant to 605 ILCS 5/6-134 and in accordance with the general election laws of Illinois:

Section 3: The Addison Township Board of Trustees further authorizes and directs that the Binding Proposition be certified to the proper Election Authority and official(s) so that the question may be submitted to the voters of Addison Township at the Election in accordance with the general election law of Illinois.

Section 4 The Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established in accordance with the general election laws of the State of Illinois by the Election Authority for voters of the Township at the Election.

Section 5: That after adoption hereof and not less than sixty-eight (68) days prior to the November 5, 2024 General Election, the Addison Township Clerk shall certify a copy hereof to the DuPage County Clerk, or any Election Authority having jurisdiction over Addison Township, in order that the Binding Proposition may be submitted to the voters of Addison Township at the November 5, 2024 General Election.

Section 6: That Notice of the Election (the “Notice”) shall be given in accordance with the general election laws of the State of Illinois by the Election Authority in compliance with Section 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (10 ILCS 5/12-5).

Section 7: That not less than ten (10) days before the date of the Election, the Clerk of the Board shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal place of the Township.

Section 8: That the ballot to be used at the Election shall be in substantially the following form, with such alterations, changes, deletions and insertions as required by Articles 24A, 24B, 24C, or other provisions of the Election Code if an electronic, mechanical or electric voting system is used at the Election:
