Updates on Current Projects and Community

Supervisor Hernandez:

- Our new Main Hall will be completed before our next Township meeting, so this is the last meeting in the event center.
- The community market saw an influx of products this week from the West Suburban Food Pantry. Clerk Vesey, who is technically a part-time elected official, but is at the township approximately 50+ hours a week, re-established long lost relationships with additional food sources. Clerk Vesey will elaborate.
- Clerk Vesey: We received an email from West Suburban Food Pantry in Wood Dale. Trustee Dare assisted me to collect 5 cases of cucumbers, 10 cases of tomatoes, and 100 loaves of bread.
- The highest number of people up until this week that have been served at the community market since we took office was 95 families. This week we served 161 families. Average number in a family is 3. 483 individuals were fed this week.
- The need is growing for the Community Market, and we will continue to source free or low-cost food options to meet the needs.
- I want to thank the Highway Department for helping us unload.
